

## Arts – Grant Application – Individuals– 2026

The application form consists of six (6) tabs, including several mandatory questions. Please complete and review each tab carefully.

The application form requests basic information about the applicant (including name, degree or professional title, and contact details), background information for research and statistical purposes (including the applicant's career stage), and information about the work for which the applicant is applying for a grant (including the field of the application, purpose of the grant, title of the proposed work, duration of the project, amount of the working grant, and any expense share

In addition, the required attachments must be submitted through the application system. On the *Other Funding tab*, applicants must report grants they have received during the past three years, as well as any other applications currently under consideration.

## Summary of the plan and objectives -tab

### How and in what ways you intend to develop, challenge yourself, and set yourself apart as an artist during the grant period?

This question aims to assess the artist's readiness to challenge themselves creatively and to pursue artistic and professional development. Describe concretely the direction in which you aim to grow and how you intend to challenge yourself and distinguish yourself as an artist during the grant period.

Your response may address, for example, artistic expression, plans for internationalisation, working methods, adopting new ways of operating and creating, or a desire to break boundaries. The purpose is not to emphasize success, but to define your own personal goal and explain how you will work to achieve it. The focus is on distinguishing yourself as a professional artist and demonstrating a desire to build your artistic identity in a way that may, in the long term, lead to significant national or international recognition.

On the Attachments tab, you can upload the required mandatory documents to your application as PDF files.

## Attachments

Attach the required attachments to your application. The application cannot be submitted unless all mandatory attachments related to your application are included.

### Application Attachments

- **Curriculum Vitae** (mandatory). It is recommended to use the researcher CV template prepared by the Finnish National Board on Research Integrity (TENK), as applicable.
- **Work Plan** (mandatory). The document length should be no more than five (5) pages.
- **Confirmation of interests** (mandatory). The foundation requires the applicant to demonstrate at the application stage that the project's collaboration partner has expressed interest in the project. This can be verified by attaching an email or document received from the partner, such as a confirmation from a producer, venue, or publisher, or an invitation from a domestic/foreign gallery. Contracts should not be submitted.
- **Image attachment** (mandatory). An image attachment is required for applications in architecture and applied arts and visual arts. It is not required for music applications.

## Naming Attachments and File Format

- Name the attachments clearly and descriptively.
- If you have trouble adding attachments on a Mac computer, try naming the attachments without special characters or Scandinavian letters å, ä, ö.
- Attachments cannot be sent by email or mail, nor can they be delivered to the office. Attachments cannot be submitted afterwards.
- Attachment files can only be of type .pdf
- The maximum file size is 3MB.

## Add a New Attachment

1. Click "Browse".
2. Select the desired file.
3. Press the framed button "Add attachment".
4. After adding the attachment, select the attachment type from the menu above the attachment.
5. **Make sure your application includes all mandatory attachments and that the attachment type describing the attachment is selected from the menu. The application will not be submitted if a required attachment type is missing.**
6. Remember to save after adding all the attachments you want.
