

## Application form: Arts - Personal grant

The application form asks for basic information about the applicant (e.g., name, academic degree or title, contact information) as well as details about the work for which the applicant is requesting a grant (e.g., the field of the application, purpose of the grant, duration of the work, amount of the work grant, and any potential expense share). In addition, the application form includes the following fields.

### HOW AND IN WHAT WAYS YOU INTEND TO DEVELOP, CHALLENGE YOURSELF, AND SET YOURSELF APART AS AN ARTIST DURING THE GRANT PERIOD?

This question aims to assess the artist's readiness to challenge themselves creatively and to pursue artistic and professional development. Describe concretely the direction in which you aim to grow and how you intend to challenge yourself and distinguish yourself as an artist during the grant period.

Your response may address, for example, artistic expression, plans for internationalisation, working methods, adopting new ways of operating and creating, or a desire to break boundaries. The purpose is not to emphasize success, but to define your own personal goal and explain how you will work to achieve it. The focus is on distinguishing yourself as a professional artist and demonstrating a desire to build your artistic identity in a way that may, in the long term, lead to significant national or international recognition.

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### SUMMARY OF THE PLAN AND OBJECTIVES OF THE WORK

What is the purpose of your grant application? Describe the goals of your work and explain what concrete outcomes will result from your work. Describe the successful outcome you are aiming for and the desired state at the end of the grant period.

What kind of audience are you aiming to reach with your work? Who is your work intended for? Why do you want to reach this audience?

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
## HOW AND BY WHAT CONCRETE MEANS DO YOU PLAN TO REACH THE AUDIENCE?

The foundation supports goal-oriented artistic work whose outcome is widely accessible to the public. Describe how and by what means you intend to make your work/artwork available and accessible to the public — for example, to be experienced, purchased, or borrowed. 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## COLLABORATORS AND PARTNERS IN THE PROJECT

In this section, you may describe, for example, a collaboration partner with whom you have had discussions, or parties with whom you are planning to collaborate. The purpose of this question is to ensure that the applicant has already developed their idea further. The collaboration partner may be a domestic or international gallery, a venue provider, a company, or another type of organization. Describe the nature of the confirmed collaboration or partnership as precisely as possible (venue, website, time, location — especially if the partner or venue is outside Finland).

On the “Other Financing” page, the applicant must provide information on grants received during the past three years as well as any other pending applications.
