The application form asks for basic information about the applicant (e.g., name, academic degree or title, contact information, title of the doctoral dissertation, and date of the defense) as well as details about the work for which the applicant is requesting a grant (e.g., the field of the application, purpose of the grant, duration of the work, amount of the work grant, and any potential expense share).

The purpose of the grant is to support the emergence of new ideas and perspectives, and to promote the researcher's smooth transition toward their desired career path. If your project is based on a completely new idea or perspective, describe what kind of new practices, models, or applications could be developed from it. Please note that the ideas or goals do not necessarily need to be based on your doctoral research.

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## SUMMARY OF THE PLAN AND OBJECTIVES OF THE WORK

The purpose of the grant is to support a recently graduated PhD in transitioning toward their own career path and working life, as well as to enable further development and deepening of the results of their doctoral research.

- In addition, prepare a project schedule. Present a clear and realistic plan for the different phases of work during the grant period and their timeline. The schedule may highlight key objectives, forms of collaboration, publications, pilot projects, or other concrete steps forward.
- A more detailed and comprehensive plan should be provided in the work plan attachment.
