

Working costs and expenses

The applicant defines the monthly working grant level and the share allocated for expenses.

You can calculate the working costs and the expenses using the following formula. By adjusting the duration of the work period and the monthly grant amount, you can determine the total working grant share.

Formula:

Working grant amount (€ / month) × duration of work (months) = total working grant share

€45,000 – total working grant share = expense share of the grant

Example:

$€2,500 \times 12 \text{ months} = €30,000$ (working grant for 12 months)

$€45,000 - €30,000 = €15,000$ (expense share of the grant)

Working Grant Level Examples

(monthly grant level)

12 months of work: €36,000 + €9,000 for expenses = €45,000	(€3,000/month)
14 months of work: €42,000 + €3,000 for expenses = €45,000	(€3,000/month)
15 months of work: €45,000 + €0 for expenses = €45,000	(€3,000/month)
16 months of work: €44,800 + €200 for expenses = €45,000	(€2,800/month)
18 months of work: €41,400 + €3,600 for expenses = €45,000	(€2,300/month)
